

CHAMPLAIN LHIN ANNOUNCES NEW HEALTH CARE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR SENIORS

June 21, 2008 - The Ontario government is buying 100 new Dodge Caravans from Windsor's Chrysler Plant to provide Ontario seniors with health-related transportation services. The Champlain LHIN is receiving 8 vans, which will provide an estimated 11,104 rides to appointments for local seniors over the course of a year.
